

## Holiday and Travel Advice Sheet

If you are planning to travel abroad or go on holiday you should consider taking a portable carbon monoxide alarm with you because it is just as important for you and your family to be safe when staying away from home.

### Which Carbon Monoxide alarm should I take on holiday?

Any carbon monoxide alarm that is certified to the latest European Standard, EN50291, would be suitable however a portable alarm that can operate free-standing would be more practical because this will not need to be permanently fixed to the wall or ceiling.

Kidde Safety models that are approved by BSI to EN50291 and benefit from the free-standing capability include the 900-0233 or the 900-0230.

### Advice if taking your alarm on holiday with you

If you buy or own a Kidde carbon monoxide alarm that you wish to take on holiday with you, please follow these steps to avoid any problems

- Remove the batteries from the alarm before packing the alarm (a 'chirping' alarm, such as when the batteries are low could raise concerns before, during or after the flight)
- Ensure that the alarm is well protected against knocks or damage whilst in-transit
- Take your user manual with you so you can refer to it if you have any concerns whilst away from home
- Locate the alarm on a flat surface, no more than 1 metre from the ground (refer to user manual for more information)
