


‘Product Selector’ for the Home Advice Sheet

There are a wide range of fire and carbon monoxide safety products available, ranging from the basic, low-cost products to the more premium products with added features for your convenience and added reassurance.

There are also many different kinds of home that we live in from small multi-dwelling flats or apartments, to caravans, 3-storey houses or large detached houses with many bedrooms.

It is therefore not possible to say exactly what each type of home should have, so instead we have attempted to provide a guideline which you may wish to follow to help you to make your family and home safe from smoke, fire or carbon monoxide.

Recommendations for a Safe Home

-  Smoke Alarm with Escape Light
-  Carbon Monoxide Alarm
-  Fire Extinguisher
-  Fire Blanket

Smoke Alarms

Minimum Requirement	At least one smoke alarm on each level of the home
Kidde Recommends	One smoke alarm in living areas (e.g. lounge or dining room) One smoke alarm in or near each bedroom or sleeping area One smoke alarm in each hallway or landing area

Carbon Monoxide Alarms

Minimum Requirement One audible alarm close to any potential source of CO in the home such as gas boilers, gas stoves, fire places and heaters.

Kidde Recommends In addition to the above advice, one CO alarm should be in or close to all bedrooms

Fire Extinguishers

Minimum Requirement One “ABC rated” fire extinguisher in the kitchen

Kidde Recommends An additional “ABC Rated” fire extinguisher in hallways and landing areas that is easy to access in the event of a fire

Fire Blankets

Minimum Requirement A fire blanket should be present in all kitchens – especially when fat or chip pan fires are used because a fire extinguisher is not recommended for use on these fires because of the added risk that the burning oils and flames would be spread further by the extinguisher spray.

Kidde Recommends An additional fire blanket close to bedrooms as this can be used to wrap around a person whose clothing has caught alight
